The 7th Hybrid Eurasian Higher Education Summit EURIE 2022 - Post-Event Report March 02-04, 2022

Day 1 - March 02, 2022

The 7th Hybrid Eurasian Higher Education Summit – EURIE2022 was organized by the Istanbul Aydin University in partnership with Marmara University and Yeditepe University for March 2, 3 and 4, 2022. The event gathered Intuitional heads from more than 150 universities across the globe for its In-person participation and FUI participated in the summit, through all the modes of participation it offered i.e. in-person, virtual and online exhibition.

On Day 1 March 02, 2022, IAU hosted the participants in Istanbul for a captivating and memorable experience. The opening ceremony of EURIE 2022 was held at IAU on 10:00 AM GMT+3, Assoc.
