Board of Governors Meeting (BoG)

The 32nd meeting of the Board of Governors (BoG) was held on July 20, 2022, under the chairmanship of Lt. Gen. Mian Muhammad Hilal Hussain, HI(M) (R), Chancellor Foundation University Islamabad (FUI). The meeting approved the recommendations of the Executive Committee regarding the budget estimates for FY 2021–2022; the establishment of the Clinical and Biomedical Research Centre (CBRC) at Foundation University School of Health Sciences (FUSH), the launching of aviation-related programs at FUSST, the Medical Entitlement Policy, and the nominations of new members to the ECM and BoG.

Academic Council Meeting (ACM)

The 29th and 30th meetings of the Academic Council were held through circulation under the chairmanship of the Rector FUI. At the 29th Meeting, held on August 3, 2022, the Council approved the award of an associate degree to MS Noor Fatima (Reg. No. FUI/FURC/F-19-BBAH-028). In the 30th Meeting, held on September 29, 2022, the Council approved the launch of Master of Science in Physical Therapy with two subspecialties: Neurological Physical Therapy (NPT) and Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Physical Therapy (CPT).

Deans Committee Meeting (DCM)

On October 12, 2022, the 76th Deans Committee Meeting (DCM) was held in the Committee Room of Foundation University Islamabad. The meeting was presided over by Maj. Gen. Nasir Dilawar Shah, HI (M) (R), Rector FUI. After thorough discussion and consideration, the committee took several important decisions, including the approval of a research-based increment for the academic year 2021-2022, the adoption of a revised fee structure for the FUCN, and amendments to the Medical Entitlement Policy for the employees of FUI.



LINKAGES

MoU with The Enablers

On June 24, 2022, FUI and The Enablers signed a Memorandum of Understanding to fortify the Professional



Development Centre (PDC) at Foundation University School of Science and Technology (FUSST). The agreement was signed by Brig. (R) Prof. Dr Abdul Ghafoor, Director FUSST and Col. (R) Farooq H. Khan, CEO The Enablers.

MoU with National Energy Efficiency and Conservation Authority (NEECA)

On July 25, 2022, Foundation University Islamabad (FUI) signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the National Energy Efficiency and Conservation Authority (NEECA). The ceremony was attended by the Secretary of the Ministry of Science and Technology and the Rector FUI.



According to the MoU, NEECA will provide 10 supervised industrial training internships to students of Information Engineering Technology in their final year at the Department of Energy Information and Futuristics at NEECA. This MoU also provides an opportunity for FUI faculty to carry out applied research.

MoU with FF Education-e-learning

FUI and Fauji Foundation Education Division (FFED) signed an MoU on Friday, September 02, 2022, to strengthen the elearning and teacher training programs of both the



organizations. Prof. Dr. Amir Gulzar, Registrar FUI and Brig. Asim Akram Siddiqui, SI (M), (R), General Manager FFED, inked the agreement on behalf of FUI and the FFED, respectively. FUI and FFED will collaborate on co-designing formal and technical education and training programs focusing on industry-academic linkages, incubation, and startups.

MoU with Lahore Garrison University

On September 5, 2022, Foundation University Islamabad (FUI) and Lahore Garrison University (LGU) became collaborative partners in a signing ceremony organised and hosted by LGU. This collaboration aims to foster academic and research ties in areas of mutual interest.



Maj. Gen. Nasir Dilawar Shah, HI (M) (R), Rector FUI, and Maj. Gen. Shahzad Sikandar, HI (M) (R), Vice Chancellor, LGU, inked the agreement. The leadership of both the universities expressed their desire to make this collaboration mutually beneficial through tangible steps.



MoU with Superior University, Lahore

On September 6, 2022, an MoU signing ceremony between Foundation University Islamabad (FUI) and Superior University, Lahore, was held at the main campus of Superior University, Lahore. Maj. Gen. Nasir Dilawar Shah HI(M), (R), Rector FUI, and Prof. Dr. Sumaira Rehman, Rector Superior University, Lahore, inked the agreement. This agreement



aims to formalize the existing linkage and pave the way for the academic communities of both the institutions to benefit from each other's initiatives and also to collaborate on new initiatives.

SEMINARS AND LECTURES

Lead From the Front, Practising Psychology in Pakistan

On March 11, 2022, the Leaders' Society of Foundation University Islamabad (FUI) organised a talk session



featuring Dr Saiyida Tasmeera, a consultant psychologist and founder of House of Wellness. Dr Tasmeera's talk, titled Lead from the Front: Practicing Psychology in Pakistan, summed up her journey of establishing House of Wellness, as well as the criteria and knowledge required to practise as a psychologist in Pakistan. She also touched on the various challenges faced by psychologists in the country and the strategies needed to cope with them.

Interactive Session by Leaders' Society, FUSST

Leaders' Society, FUSST, organised an interactive session on June 17, 2022. Raja Zia ul Haq, a renowned motivational



speaker and CEO of a non-profit, youth-focused organisation Youth Club, was invited to answer different questions by students from the different departments of FUSST. These queries were largely about an identity crisis, relationship management, gender issues, and issues related to practising religion. The session was interactive and the incubatees gained practical experience.

Fundamentals of Case Study Teaching and Writing

An interview preparation session followed the Curriculum Vitae preparation session. An interactive session regarding the shortlisting of Curriculum Vitae with Mr Syed Ali Musa was also held, in which factors contributing to CV shortlisting at the different stages of CV shortlisting were discussed. At the end, Mr. Syed Ali Musa and Mr. Naveed Ramzan answered questions from the participants.

After the initial stage, she discussed different aspects of project design and representation. The seminar ended with interactive session with students whose queries were answered.

Women Entrepreneurs and Banking on Equality

The Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at FUCD&H organised and conducted the AOCMF Advanced Seminar in Orthognathic Surgery on October 20, 2022 (sponsored by the AO Cranio-Maxillofacial Foundation). TRAININGS, WORKSHOPS AND CONFERENCES

Environmental Society

The Environmental Society at Foundation University School of Health Sciences was established to spread awareness of environmental issues and take initiatives to conserve



biodiversity and create a healthy ecosystem. The first event in this regard was the meet and greet session organised on June 21, 2022. The Environmental Society held a comprehensive workshop titled *Solution, not Pollution!* on the consumerism crisis on June 23, 2022. The students interacted with Mr. Kamran Shezad, a climate and social justice activist and member of the multi-faith advisory council to the United Nations. The workshop was highly interactive, and the space buzzed with creative, profound,

Every year, more than forty thousand women in Pakistan die from breast cancer. Keeping the spirit of organising pink ribbon day alive the Department of Community Medicine, under the guidance of HOD Brig. Prof. Dr. Naila Azam organised a training workshop on October 19, 2022, for one CME credit. Dr. Tahira Amjad, Associate Professor of Community Medicine, was in charge of the workshop's



applied training of trainers (ToT) model for self-breast examination for early detection. The participants were female faculty members and students from FUMC, FUCD, FUCP, and FUCN. The Director of FUSH, Maj. Gen. Imran Fazal, HI (M) (R), gave his remarks and appreciated the Community Medicine faculty's efforts for this noble cause. The PowerPoint presentations on What Breast Cancer is. Three FCPS residents Dr. Fatima Ali Raza, Dr Sarah Bakhsh, and Dr Asma Anjum presented protocols and demonstrations of self-breast examination. The participants took an active part in practise sessions. These one hundred and six participants pledged to advocate educate and empower at least ten other females from the community within a month, achieving a minimum target of one thousand females. Their contribution to the community was acknowledged by through certificates of appreciation.

Do No Harm! Preventing Nosocomial MDR and XDR Infections

Pathology Department, FUMC/FFH, conducted a Microbiology Seminar and hands-on workshop in collaboration with the National Institute of Health (NIH) and Pakistan Biological Safety Association (PBSA) on October



19, 2022, at Foundation University Medical College, Islamabad. The theme of the event was *Do No Harm! Preventing Nosocomial MDR and XDR Infections*. The event's objective was to train the students, house officers, postgraduate trainees, and nursing staff to prevent nosocomial infections. Maj. Gen. Eijaz Ghani, Consultant Virologist, AFIP Rawalpindi, graced the occasion as the chief guest. Maj. Gen. Professor Imran Fazal, HI (M), (R), Director FUSH / Principal FUMC, Commandant FFH and Associate Deans FUMC graced the occasion. Students of FUMC, FUCD&H, FUCP, and FUCN, alongwith house officers and postgraduate trainees at FFH, actively participated in the seminar and hands-on workshop.

Master Trainers on "Khud ko Pehchano"

The Community Medicine Department, under the leadership of Brig. Prof. Dr. Naila Azam ® organised the training of Master Trainers for the *Khud Ko Pehchano* project in collaboration with Greenstar Social Marketing (GSM) on Monday, October 24, 2022. This program aimed to create social awareness of sexual and reproductive health and rights, premarital counselling, healthy timing and birth spacing (HTSP), family planning methods, gender-based violence and mitigation strategies. To achieve the target of



"Khud Ko Pehchano" project, 40 nominated faculty members from both FUSH and FUSST were trained as master trainers. They will further conduct trickle-down training for 800 FUI students by February 2023. The movement was led by the CEO of GSM and his team, including the manager of the KKP project and a GSM technical expert. The session started with a brief introduction of the project, followed by a pretest. Besides

the training on the topics mentioned above, seed funding and mentorship program were also introduced. The session concluded with a post test, certificate distribution ceremony, and group photo. The master trainers pledged to stay committed to the "Khud Ko Pehchano" project and achieve the target of training 800 FUI students.

Wire Bending Skills in Orthodontics

A workshop *Wire Bending Skills in Orthodontics* was arranged by the Department of Orthodontics in the Foundation University College of Dentistry on the October



26-27, 2022. Postgraduate trainees from KPK and the twin cities got hands-on experience of fabricating various loops and bends practised in orthodontics under the guidance provided by Dr. Afeef Umar Zia from Margalla Institute of Health Sciences and Dr. Anwar Ali Shah from Shifa College of Dentistry.

Basic Dental Implant Prosthetics

The Prosthodontics Department conducted a one-day workshop titled *Introduction to Basic Dental Implant Prosthetics* on November 3, 2022. It included lectures, demonstrations, and hands-on training sessions. The esteemed guest speaker, Brig. Mubashir Sharif (HOD, Prosthodontics Department, AFID) and other facilitators delivered lectures on the different types of impression

NEWS AND EVENTS

Interpretive Phenomenological Analysis

The Department of Applied Psychology at the National University of Modern Languages (NUML) Rawalpindi conducted a pre-conference workshop on Interpretative Phenomenological Analysis on July 18, 2022. Dr. Saima Ehsan, Assistant Professor of Psychology, Foundation University Islamabad (FUI), Graduate Member of the British Psychological Society (UK), and IPA representative in Pakistan, was the resource person. The workshop was insightful and enabled the participants to learn the theoretical background, data collection, and analysis of IPA. Faculty members NUML, students from the social sciences discipline, and participants from other universities attended the IPA workshop.





RESEARCHER'S CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM

First Phase

The Higher Education Commission, in collaboration with the British Council, under its program titled *Pak-UK Education Gateway*, organised a four-day *Researcher's Capacity Building program* on August 2–5, 2022, for the



selected researcher whose NRPU projects could not be approved for funding. The resource persons were Prof. Elena Gaura and Prof. James Brusey from Coventry University, UK. Dr. Hira Ashraf from FUMC and Dr. Usman Ahmed from FUCD&H. Dr Nazima Ellahi and Dr. Muhammad Awais from FMS participated in the first phase of the training program. The program's core objective was to build researchers' capacity by improving the quality of research proposals, promoting multi-disciplinarity, securing more research grants, and managing grants more effectively. The four-day training program consisted of informative discussions, interactive sessions, and presentations by the participants. The trainers equipped the participants with skills and tools to write effective and grant-winning proposals and provided an insight into the resourcing and costing of the research grant. It is important to mention that the project presented by Dr. Hira Ashraf was nominated as the best project and won the hypothetical funding. The trainers appreciated the project proposal and advised the students to formally submit the project to HEC in an upcoming call for funding.

Second Phase

The Higher Education Commission, in collaboration with the British Council, under its program titled *Pak-UK Education Gateway*, organised a four-day *Researchers Capacity Building program* on September 5 - 8, 2022. Dr. Vaughan Shilton and Dr. Marco Van de Wiel from Coventry University, UK, were the resource persons who used various techniques during the training sessions,



including direct delivery, group activities and depicting individual work. Prof. Dr. Rooh ul Amin and Dr. Sadaf Ahsan from FUSST attended the training, while Dr. Hina Shafi and Dr. Saba Murad from FUCP attended the program's second phase.

Third Phase

The Higher Education Commission, in collaboration with the British Council, under its program titled *Pak-UK Education Gateway*, organised a five-day "Researchers Capacity Building program" from September 12 to 16, 2022,



for the selected researchers whose NRPU projects are in progress. Prof. Sheena Gardner and Prof. Andrée Woodcock from Coventry University, UK, conducted the training, which was reinforced by a 2-hour lecture led by Prof. Richard Dashwood. Prof. Dr Iffat Rohail, Dr Nadia Shafeeq from FUSST, and Dr Sana Nadeem from FUMC attended the training in the program's third phase.

Fifth Phase

The Higher Education Commission, in collaboration with the British Council, under its program titled *Pak-UK Education Gateway*, organised the fifth phase of the *Researchers Capacity Building program* from September 19–22, 2022, for the selected researchers. Dr. Tania Arshad Siddiqui, Assistant Professor, and Dr. Qaiser Masud Sheikh, Assistant Professor, from FUCD, whereas Engr. FCPS/FRCPath Mock Examination Course


